^{***}The Rio Grande District is defined as the area from North Temple to 700 South and State Street to I-15. However, this area overlaps other districts covered with the SLCPD CompStat Report, namely parts of Districts 3 & 4. As a result, the data contained within the Rio Grande District may also be listed in the data for other areas. Page 2 of 9
